Jesus has come to the end of his sermon after covering a lot of ground. He finishes it with a few things to watch out for and he does that by making use of a series of four contrasts, all of which have to do with obedience.

- What is Jesus warning about?
- Where does obedience fit with each of the contrasts?
- Are there things that you need to apply to your own life?

The Narrow Gate and the Wide Gate (13-14)

Good Tree Bad Tree (15-20)

Those Who Do God's Will and Those Who Don't (21-23)

Wise and Foolish Builders (24-27)
